## DMV 2 GO BUS

The DMV 2 Go Bus brings services done in the DMV offices to towns, universities or other organizations.

Visit the DMV Bus to:

- Apply for or renew your ID card
- Apply for or renew your driver's license - take road and knowledge tests; get your picture taken. Reinstate driving privileges.
- Apply for a Veteran ID card.
- Get a copy of your driving record.
- Obtain vehicle titles, license plates, decals, transcripts.
- Order disabled parking placards or plates.
- Apply for certified copies of Virginia vital records, including birth, death, marriage, and divorce certificates.
- And more!

The DMV 2 Go bus will be set up in the Plains District Community Center Parking Lot on **August 1st from 11 am to 4 pm.**

# CELEBRATING 25 YEARS IN EDUCATION!

Reformation Lutheran Church Preschool-a very successful community outreach- is celebrating its 25th year of service to the community. We celebrate this milestone with pride and gratitude. Some former students have returned and made inquiries about their children enrolling in the program. We want you to know we are alive and well and going strong! We are located in New Market, and also serve the Timberville/Broadway area.

Reformation Preschool is different from daycare. Our preschool was designed to introduce and prepare young children (ages 3 and 4) for the school setting and higher learning. Reformation has two educated and experienced teachers on staff who hold degrees in Early Childhood and Elementary Education and who follow a state curriculum designed by early childhood experts. Although we have a religious exemption, we follow and adhere to state and local guidelines consistent with licensing.

While we do nurture and care for the children, it is not a child care service. It is schooling for the younger population! Our goal is to teach the whole child (physically, emotionally, spiritually, academically, and socially). We instruct daily in math, language, science, Bridgewater Community Center, social studies, art, physical education, and music. We facilitate activities that build social skills such as team work, sharing, turn-taking, verbal communication, personal responsibility, etc. The children enjoy age appropriate tasks and activities that are fun and exciting, yet in reality they are learning through carefully designed play!

Reformation Lutheran Church Preschool is a great place to be, and it is an honor to serve New Market and adjoining towns. Please call or visit us if you are interested in a quality learning environment for your child!

We are located at 9283 Congress Street, New Market, Va.

Our hours are MWF 9a.m. to 2p.m. (age 4) and T-Thurs. 9-11:30 (age 3).
